

All bikes will need to go through a basic safety and tech inspection to look for any safety concerns for the rider and other racers.

We'll be looking for any sharp edges (quite often on grips that have worn through), loose parts, overextended seats and handlebars, properly rotating tires, that the bike is a genuine Strider Bike and any other obvious safety concerns or rule violations.

In the instance of a Strider Snow Ski race, we will also be looking to see that all the Strider Snow Skis are attached properly. All rules must be adhered to.

We also need to verify your racer's helmet is properly fit. The best-case situation would be if you could bring your rider, Strider Bike (with Strider Snow Skis if applicable to the event) and helmet to packet pickup on Friday before the race. If you are unable to do so, we can finalize Tech Inspection on race day.

Any concerns would need to be addressed before the child is allowed to race, so again, we would suggest doing packet pickup on Friday if possible. That would also give us an opportunity to address any issues in a calm, non-rushed atmosphere and be able to explain to you what to expect on race day.
