

Generally speaking, at Strider events such as the Strider Cup World Championship and Strider Cup races, we race rain or shine, heat or snow. To further clarify:

- If you wake up and it is pouring rain, the race is a go.
- If it is snowing, the race is a go.
- If it is hot, the race is a go.
- If it is cold, the race is a go.

Please plan to dress everybody in your family accordingly and use your judgement regarding your child's limitations.

If weather conditions are "severe" (such as a tornado warning, tornado watch, thunderstorm, electrical storm, heavy rain, flooding, etc.), the event will be delayed until such conditions pass. If the delay exceeds 6 hours, the event will be canceled.

If we must cancel an event due to severe weather conditions, emails will be sent to all registered racers, and announcements will be made on Strider's social networking channels including Facebook and Twitter.

For events requiring a race fee, race fees are non-refundable. If a race is canceled, a \$50 gift certificate will be provided to all affected racers. If a race is canceled and the racer has not picked up their registration bag, the bag is forfeited and will not be mailed out post event.

Strider Cup events and the Strider Cup World Championship do not have backup days.
